<b>DESCRIPTION:</b>	<b>AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 28 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO CHARITABLE GAMING.</b>

*In accordance with 29 Del. C. §913, the following information is provided relating to licenses and fees.*

**Description of the Legislation:**

This Act is effective six months after its enactment into law. This Act would establish an annual raffle license that will allow an organization to hold up to twenty raffles per year. The cost of the annual raffle license established by the Act is \$300.

The annual license established by this Act is in addition to the per raffle license currently authorized in Regulation 102-6.2 of Title 10 of the Delaware Administrative Code. This license is currently set at \$15/raffle. According to the Department of State, Division of Professional Regulation, there were 48 such licenses issued to 30 different organizations in 2023 resulting in revenue of \$720.

**Affected Entities:**

Department of State, Division of Professional Regulation, and raffle holders.

**Fiscal Impact:**

If all previous organizations apply for the newly created annual license in lieu of the existing per event license, the maximum net revenue generated would be \$8,280. However, because it is unknown if all organizations will apply for the new license, the actual revenue generated is indeterminable.

**Intended Use of Revenue:**

Funds generated through the sale of annual licenses would be retained by the Division of Professional Regulation to be used for administration and enforcement activities.
