

153rd GENERAL ASSEMBLY FISCAL NOTE

BILL: SENATE BILL NO. 47

SPONSOR: Senator Pettyjohn

DESCRIPTION: AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 1 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO A

NATIONAL DAY OF MOURNING DUE TO THE DEATH OF A CURRENT OR

FORMER PRESIDENT.

Assumptions:

1. This Act becomes effective upon signature by the Governor.

- 2. This Act establishes that state government offices are to close when a National Day of Mourning is declared due to the death of a current or former President of the United States.
- 3. This Act creates a state holiday and therefore requires holiday/overtime pay for applicable state employees in 24/7 facilities/operations.
- 4. Based on data from the State's financial and accounting system on State declared holidays during the month of January 2025, the state General Fund cost associated with overtime pay for a legal holiday is estimated to be \$843,224 (including other employment costs).
- 5. Because it is unknown when National Days of Mourning due to the death of a current or former President of the United States will occur, the fiscal impact is indeterminable.
