

153rd GENERAL ASSEMBLY FISCAL NOTE

BILL: HOUSE BILL NO. 112

SPONSOR: Representative Shupe

DESCRIPTION: AN ACT TO AMEND TITLES 15 AND 21 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING

TO PHOTOGRAPHIC IDENTIFICATION IN DELAWARE ELECTIONS AND

OBTAINING NONDRIVER IDENTIFICATION CARDS.

Assumptions:

1. This Act becomes effective upon signature by the Governor.

- 2. This Act requires the Department of Transportation, Division of Motor Vehicles (DMV) to issue nondriver identification cards for no cost with subsequent nondriver identification cards provided at a cost of \$20 each. Currently, the fee is \$40 for the first identification card and \$5 for subsequent cards. The DMV cost to issue each nondriver identification card is approximately \$7 per card.
- 3. The DMV issues approximately 33,325 nondriver identification cards per year and collects approximately \$1,329,495 in associated fees, which are deposited to the Transportation Trust Fund (TTF).
- 4. Nondriver identification card revenue is pledged in Delaware Transportation Authority (DTA) Revenue Bonds, and until all outstanding bonds issued under the Trust Agreement are defeased, the State and DTA are prohibited from suspending the nondriver identification card fees. The amount needed to settle outstanding DTA bonds is \$975,830,000.
- 5. The DMV estimates revenue loss will increase 3% annually.
