BILL: SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 4

SPONSOR: Senator Hoffner

DESCRIPTION: DIRECTING THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES AND

ENVIRONMENTAL CONTROL TO COMMISSION AN ARCHITECTURAL STUDY OF

KINGSTON-UPON HULL.

Assumptions:

1. This Joint Resolution takes effect upon signature by the Governor.

- 2. This Joint Resolution directs the Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Control (Department) to commission an architectural study and submit a report to the Governor, General Assembly and the Director and Librarian of the Division of Legislative Services no later than March 31, 2026, regarding the historical structure, Kingston-upon Hull in Kent County.
- 3. The report must include the following:
 - a. A recommendation on the course of action for Kingston-upon Hull.
 - b. Consideration and recommendations for an entity to manage Kingston-upon Hull.
 - c. Consideration and recommendations for the use of Kingston-upon Hull for revenuegenerating activities.
- 4. The Department estimates that the cost for the architectural study will be approximately \$80,000.
