<b>DESCRIPTION:</b>	<b>DIRECTING THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES AND ENVIRONMENTAL CONTROL TO COMMISSION AN ARCHITECTURAL STUDY OF KINGSTON-UPON HULL.</b>

**Assumptions:**

1. This Joint Resolution takes effect upon signature by the Governor.
2. This Joint Resolution directs the Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Control (Department) to commission an architectural study and submit a report to the Governor, General Assembly and the Director and Librarian of the Division of Legislative Services no later than March 31, 2026, regarding the historical structure, Kingston-upon Hull in Kent County.
3. The report must include the following:
  - a. A recommendation on the course of action for Kingston-upon Hull.
  - b. Consideration and recommendations for an entity to manage Kingston-upon Hull.
  - c. Consideration and recommendations for the use of Kingston-upon Hull for revenue-generating activities.
4. The Department estimates that the cost for the architectural study will be approximately \$80,000.
