

153rd GENERAL ASSEMBLY FISCAL NOTE

BILL:	HOUSE BILL NO. 180
SPONSOR:	Representative Harris
DESCRIPTION:	AN ACT PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE V OF THE DELAWARE CONSTITUTION RELATING TO VOTING.

Assumptions:

- 1. This Act takes effect upon final adoption of the proposal constitutional amendment in accordance with Del. Const. art. XVI, § 1, following passage by the 153rd General Assembly and the subsequent General Assembly.
- 2. This Act amends the Delaware Constitution relating to voting. For purposes of this fiscal projection, it is assumed that the passage of a subsequent constitutional amendment referred to in assumption one may occur sometime during the first half of the 154th General Assembly, resulting in this Act becoming effective sometime between January and June 2027, or during Fiscal Year 2027.
- 3. This Act would require the Delaware Criminal Justice Information System (DELJIS) to perform system modifications for core criminal-history and voter-eligibility services, update data-exchange interfaces with the Department of Elections, and conduct comprehensive regression and useracceptance testing with partner agencies. These technical adjustments, business-rule changes, quality assurance testing, and deployment validation are projected to incur a one-time cost of \$30,000.
