

153rd GENERAL ASSEMBLY FISCAL NOTE

BILL: SENATE SUBSTITUTE NO. 1 FOR SENATE BILL NO. 8

SPONSOR: Senator Pinkney

DESCRIPTION: AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 11 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO

PROBATION AND SENTENCING PROCEDURES.

Assumptions:

1. This Act becomes effective 180 days upon signature by the Governor.

- 2. This Act codifies the standard conditions of probation to be used by the courts and the Department of Correction (DOC).
- 3. This Act would require the DOC to make programming changes to its Delaware Automated Correction System (DACS) for enhancements and modifications to reflect and enforce the newly established statewide standard conditions of probation. The required system modifications involve system architecture enhancements to the standard conditions management module, allowing for special condition customization, and various changes to probationer reporting and notification tracking. The DOC estimates that these changes with its contracted system vendor for the DACS would be a one-time cost of \$100,000.
